ORDINANCE NO. 64

ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR IMPOSITION AND COLLECTION OF SOLID WASTE RATE INCREASES FOR FISCAL YEAR 2019-20, 2020-21, 2021-22, 2022-23 and 2023-24

WHEREAS, the Burbank Sanitary District (“the District”), has entered into an agreement with GreenWaste on July 19, 2016, to provide garbage collection services to our residents through June 30, 2027. This agreement allows GreenWaste to increase their rates annually based on the annual percentage change in the Consumer Price Index (CPI) for All Urban Consumers for the San Francisco/Oakland/San Jose Metropolitan area from February to February each year. The next fiscal year CPI increase is 3.53%. Because the actual CPI increases are not known for the next four fiscal years, the maximum rate of increase for garbage charges are set at not-to-exceed four (4) percent per year. In the event CPI increases exceed 4%, the District will conduct a separate public hearing process to increase garbage collection fee over 4%.

WHEREAS solid waste fees are paid directly to GreenWaste Recovery, Inc. for services provided. The annual CPI rate increase are designed to ensure that revenue collected from solid waste rates is sufficient to cover the full costs of providing solid waste services.
