### Why the Changes?

- ☐ Current contract expires June 30, 2007
- Must comply with new state and federal laws and regulations
  - □ Clean air collection vehicles
  - State landfill diversion requirements
  - New recycling programs to meet current and future requirements
- □ Rates have not changed since 1993
  - □ Fuel increased by over <u>300%</u>
  - □ Labor increased by over **200%**
  - □ Landfill disposal increased by over <u>450%</u>
  - □ Collection vehicles increased by over 225%







### Steps Taken By the District

- □ Current hauler declined District's offer to extend the current contract
- □ Conducted a Competitive Proposal Process
  - □ Received 3 proposals
  - □ One company was determined to be non-responsive
  - Negotiated with the 2 qualified companies
  - □ Received price concessions from GreenWaste Recovery







### Your New Hauler: GreenWaste Recovery

- Company size
  - Privately held company based in San Jose in operation for 16 years
  - Will serve over 260,000 households in California by the end of 2007
  - □ Currently serves San Jose, Petaluma, Woodside, Portola Valley, San Juan Bautista, Lexington Hills and Santa Cruz County
  - □ \$41.1 million in annual revenue
- Recycling Facilities to be used
  - GWR facilities in San Jose
- □ Provide new carts/bins
- □ Split-body truck 1 truck for both <u>garbage and</u> <u>green waste</u>
  - □ Requires 2 vehicle stops per residential account




